<p><b>2 points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All problems complete</li> <li>▪ All necessary steps shown as modeled in Notes</li> </ul> <p><b>1 point</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Incomplete in any way (INC problems, INC diagrams, INC work), OR</li> <li>▪ Late assignment, if completed by chapter test date</li> </ul> <p><b>0 points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Very little-to-no problems completed, OR</li> <li>▪ Completed after the chpt. Test</li> </ul> <p><b>*</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Student wrote down the answers only, OR</li> <li>▪ Assignment not shown to teacher (students w/ any *'s are <u>not</u> eligible for Ex. Cr. at end of trimester)</li> </ul> <p><b>AB</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Absent on day HW was checked - need to show your teacher!</li> </ul> <hr style="border-top: 1px dashed black;"/> <p>Note: Having <u>answers only</u> on daily HW earns a "0", however, a point can still be earned on the HC for having just the correct answer.</p>	<p>Completed daily homework (from spiral notebooks) will be used for HC's - but NOT the textbook.</p> <p>To earn full credit for any problem on a HC, you need all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Original problem copied from textbook (<u>not</u> multi-sentence work problems), including any diagrams associated with the problem</li> <li>▪ All necessary steps, as modeled in the Notes</li> <li>▪ Correct answer (including letter choice for <i>multiple choice</i> questions)</li> </ul>

**Late assignments** (excluding excused absences) will earn a maximum of **1 pt.** if completed prior to taking the test for that chapter.

**Extra credit** will only be offered at the end of each trimester for students with **no missing assignments.**
